How to: Stream Live Video Broadcasts

Needed: Camcorder with USB out to computer, Cable from webcam / camcorder to Laptop or Desktop computer; high-speed Internet connection with a minimum of 400 kbps upload speed.



Log into your ad listing with your saved email and password.

Click on the Free Listing option. This opens the Adform page where you make basic changes, text and pictures. You will enter webcam code after creating a Ustream.tv account to obtain video server service.

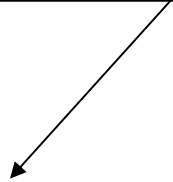

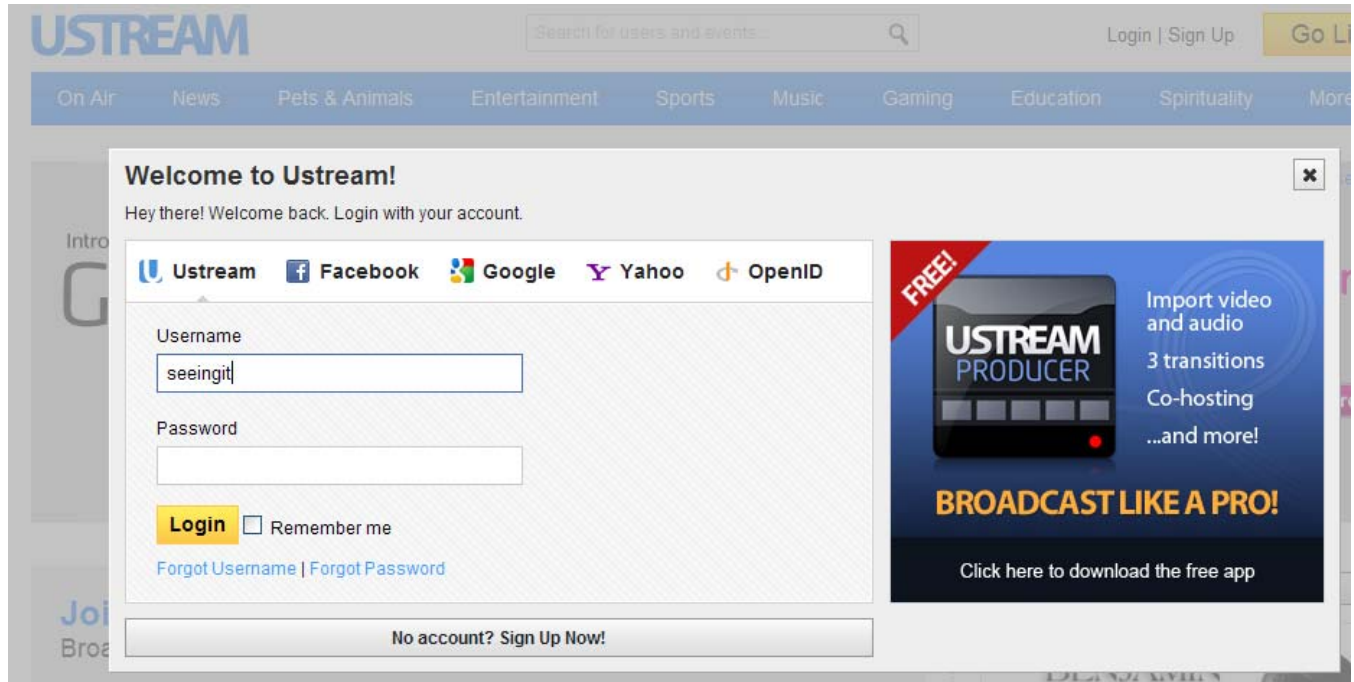
